POSTER INSTRUCTIONS FOR PAPER POSTERS:

- All Posters in Portrait.
- Format
Max: 100 cm wide x 150 cm high
Recommended: 90 cm wide x 120 cm high
- The heading should include the title of the paper, authors, institutions and location of institutions.
- Letters should be at least 35 mm high.
- The title should be emphasized by the use of a bold type face. This writing should be easily readable at a distance of 2 meters.
- The text can be broken up by the inclusion of drawings, charts and photos.

- Lettering for text and illustrations must be at least 10 mm high. Letters should be bold enough to enable viewers to read the poster from a distance of 2 meters (6 feet).
- Tacks and technical equipment will be available for the hanging of posters.

RECOMMENDED STRUCTURE:

Background – to include 3-5 telegraphic sentences outlining information necessary to understand the study and why it was done.

Aim – the aim of the study

Method – outline methods used

Results – should be presented as graphs or charts. Provide a legend to explain symbols or other details.

Conclusions – should be stated in large type. Many viewers read this first, hence it should be easy to understand.
